- Eagle Softball Elite Event:** Nov. 16th (8am-4pm) & Nov. 17th (9am-1pm)
 - Registration is limited to 40 participants

Our Emory Softball staff, players, and alum host this instructional event. This is geared for players looking to get an honest feel of what it means be an athlete at the collegiate level.

- Elite Winter Hitting Clinic:** December 14-15th (10am-1pm)
 - Registration is limited to 40 participants
 - Cost is \$55 per attendee
 - This is designed for 7th-12th grades, girls and young women that are interested in carving out a new swing, digging out of a slump, learning problem solving drills for varying pitches, building better weight transfer to improve power & leg drive, and improving out mental approach.

- Elite Defense Instruction:** December 14-15th (1:30-4:30pm)
 - Registration is limited to 30 participants
 - Cost is \$55 per attendee
 - This is designed for 7th-12th grades. This event gives the attendees full control of what area of their games they wish to improve. Unlike traditional camps at this event each player gets to decide what they want to learn and take away from this experience. It could be better footwork, throwing, advanced or beginning defensive strategies, etc, etc.

Penny Siqueiros Emory Head Coach (16th year)

Bio - Penny Siqueiros, former coach and player at Florida State, was appointed the first Emory University head softball coach in the summer of 1998. In 15 seasons at Emory, Siqueiros has amassed a career record of 487-147-1 with three softball World Series appearances, three NCAA regional championships, eleven NCAA tournament berths and six conference titles.

Following the 2013 season, she ranks among the top 10 active NCAA Division III coaches for best career winning percentage (.757). Siqueiros has directed the Eagles to eleven seasons of 30 or more wins and three 40 or more triumphs.

She has been honored as the NCAA Division III regional Coaching Staff of the Year by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association in 2002, 2006 and 2007. She and her assistants have been honored seven times as the conference Coaching Staff of the Year.

Siqueiros has mentored eight different players to a total of eleven All-America berths, the most recent being Megan Light (1st team) and Amanda Kardys (3rd team) in 2013

While at Florida State Coach Siqueiros competed in 3 NCAA Division I College World Series leading the team offensively each year. FSU finished 3rd, 5th, & 7th respectively each of those appearances. As an assistant Coach at Florida State, she worked with Connie Clark (current Texas Head Coach) & JoAnne Graf (former FSU Head Coach). During her stint as an assistant, FSU attended one Division I College World Series and two NCAA Regional Appearances.
